Role Summary:

This is a highly impactful role, as some of our residents experience food insecurity and look forward to a hot meal shared with their community.

Role Qualifications/Requirements:

- Basic understanding and knowledge of food preparation and cooking
- Comfortable with chopping and washing ingredients
- Able to pass a background check
- A desire to engage with our residents and align with our values of harm reduction and Housing First
- Able to commit for a minimum of 6 months on a weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly cadence
- Have reliable transportation to and from the building
