 - HDMI cable
 - DJ table (optional)
 - Karaoke software
- Able to pass a background check
- Have reliable transportation to and from the building
- Able to commit for at least 6 months on a bi-weekly or monthly cadence
- A desire to engage with our residents and to align with or learn more about our values of Housing First and harm reduction
