Role Qualifications/Requirements:

- Must own some gardening supplies to use and share with residents
- Able to pass a background check
- Must have a desire to engage with our residents and to align with or learn more about our values of Housing First and harm reduction
- Able to commit for at least 6 months on a bi-weekly or monthly cadence
- Have reliable transportation to and from the building
