



Plymouth Supply Center Volunteer

Are you looking to make a difference in your community and positively impact people's lives? Volunteering with Plymouth Housing is a great way to bring joy, belonging, and well-being to individuals who previously experienced long-term homelessness.

Role Summary:

We are looking for several volunteers to assist in running our new Plymouth Supply Center (PSC). The PSC is a store for Plymouth residents to come and shop for essential household items such as hygiene products, cleaning products, and much more. Plymouth residents typically live on an annual income of less than \$10,000 a year, making it difficult to maintain common household goods. All items at the PSC are free to Plymouth residents.

PSC Volunteers will be responsible for stocking supplies, organizing goods, accepting and inventorying new donations, and acting as a "cashier" to check out residents. Shifts are 2 hours long on Wednesdays and Thursdays from 12:00pm-2:00pm and 2:00pm-4:00pm.

Role Qualifications/Requirements:

- A desire to engage with our residents and to align with or learn more about our mission and values of harm reduction and housing first
- 18 years or older
- Must be available for shifts described above
- Able to pass a background check
- Able to commit for at least 6 months on a weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly cadence
- Have reliable transportation to and from the PSC
