What Is Permanent Supportive Housing?

Permanent supportive housing (PSH) is a **proven**, **cost-effective**, and **compassionate** housing model that Plymouth uses to help people out of homelessness.

By **"permanent,"** we mean that there is no time limit on our housing.

By **"supportive,"** we mean that we provide on-site services that help our residents thrive.

A STABLE, CARING PLACE WHERE RESIDENTS CAN HEAL

Each Plymouth resident is paired up with a housing case manager who gets to know them and helps them access services.

- On-site nursing and medical care
- Behavioral health treatment
- Substance use treatment
- Hospice care
- Veterans counseling
- Family reunification
- Money management programs
- Community activities and outings

- **96%** At least one disability
- 59% Substance use disorder
- 62% Mental health disability
- **40%** Physical disability or chronic health condition
