Her career includes leading a historic statewide effort to repeal an extreme abortion ban in South Dakota and serving on the boards of Planned Parenthood Votes and Powerful Voices, creating spaces for BIPOC and gender-expansive youth to thrive.

Lindsay’s experience spans national fundraising and advocacy efforts with No Kid Hungry; raising more than \$100 million for Hillary for America; and mobilizing billions of dollars for climate change investment through Climate Lead.
