

Plymouth Housing has about **450 dedicated staff** serving **nearly 1,500 residents** at **18 buildings** throughout King County. What are the demographics of our permanent supportive housing residents, and how much support do they receive from Plymouth?

RESIDENT DEMOGRAPHICS

Plymouth provides permanent housing and on-site support services to single adults who have experienced long-term homelessness. Of those we served in 2025:

DIVERSITY

54% Of residents are Black, Indigenous, or People of Color

DISABILITY

92% At least one disability

62% Mental health disability

57% Substance use disorder

31% Physical disability or chronic health condition

GENDER

29% Female

70% Male

1% Nonbinary

VETERANS

1 in 12 residents are veterans

STAGE OF LIFE

Over half of residents are seniors (55 and older)



PROGRAMMING AND SERVICES PROVIDED

- **51,000+ supportive services** — like individualized case management, substance use and behavioral health treatment, veterans counseling, etc. — were provided to residents last year.
- **95% of residents** made use of at least one of these voluntary services last year.
- **200+ resident outings or community activities** take place at our buildings every month.

Plymouth Housing's mission is to eliminate homelessness and address its causes by preserving, developing and operating safe, quality, supportive housing and by providing adults experiencing homelessness with opportunities to stabilize and improve their lives.
